10. Shortlisting Criteria.

(a) RT JCO.

- (i) Paper-I is common to candidates and is a qualifying exam only. Candidates scoring min 40% marks in Paper-I will only be assessed in Paper-II. Marks obtained in Paper-I will not be counted for preparation of merit list for appearing in the interview for final selection.
- (ii) Candidates who have been shortlisted for rally based on merit of marks obtained in the online examination will be put on Rtg Dte website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in.
- (iii) The names of candidates shortlisted for the rally and further for the interview will be put on Rtg Dte website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. These candidates will be interviewed by board of officers at MEG & Centre, Bangalore and 39 GTC, Varanasi, as applicable.
- (iv) For selection of Granthi the ability to deliver Kirtan should be a mandatory pre requisite which will be assessed by the interview board.
- (v) Candidates scoring a minimum 50 out of 100 marks (50%) will qualify in the interview.
- (vi) The final selection will be based on merit list drawn on the basis of the total marks obtained in Paper-II and Interview.
- (vii) No bonus marks is entitled to son of Serving/Ex-Servicemen/War Widow/ Widow and Sportsmen/NCC/Computer certificate holders.

(b) HAV (SAC).

- (i) Candidate has to score minimum of 40% marks each in Paper-1 and Paper-2 separately to pass the exam.
